



# Report From a Survey Conducted on Public Opinion of The Citizens In The Area of Discrimination

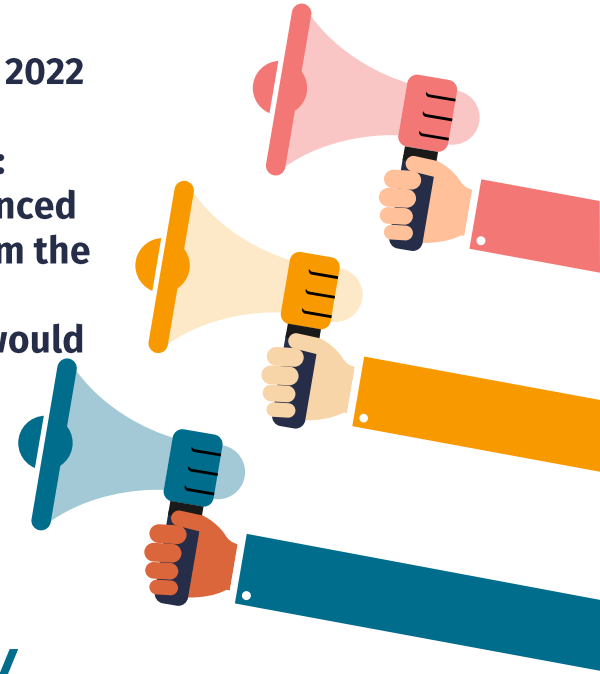
Used for the research was a representative sample of the territory of the Republic of North Macedonia, aged 18+. The research was conducted on a total of 1200 respondents within a sample of the Census conducted in 2021, and published data from the State Statistics Office. For the purposes of the research, a telephone CATI interview was used



The findings are part of a wider survey conducted between December 2022 and January 2023 into issues of discrimination.

The research questions were grouped into the following sections:

- Recognition on the concept of discrimination and personally experienced discrimination as well as discrimination that happened to people whom the respondents knew
- Perceptions and hypothetical situations of discrimination and how would the respondents react to them

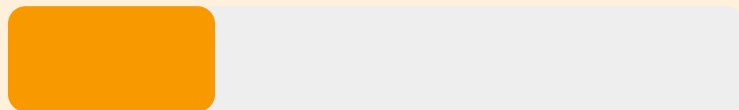


## How do you understand discrimination?



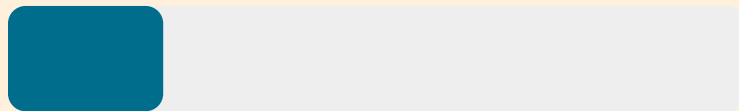

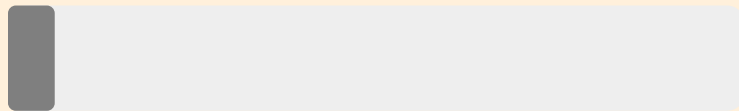

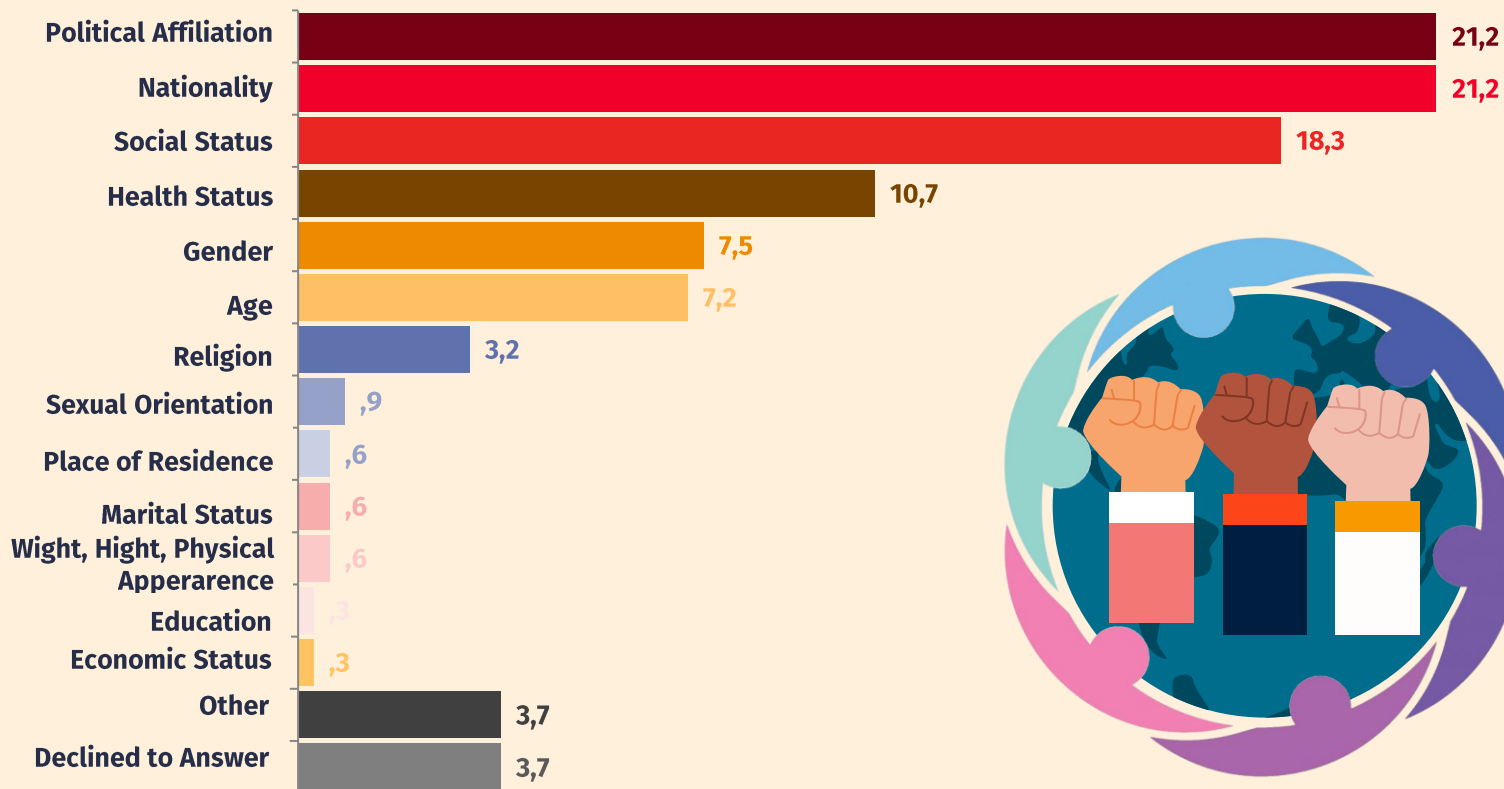
# Have you ever been discriminated??

(Answers from those who answered affirmatively to the question "Have you ever been discriminated against?" )



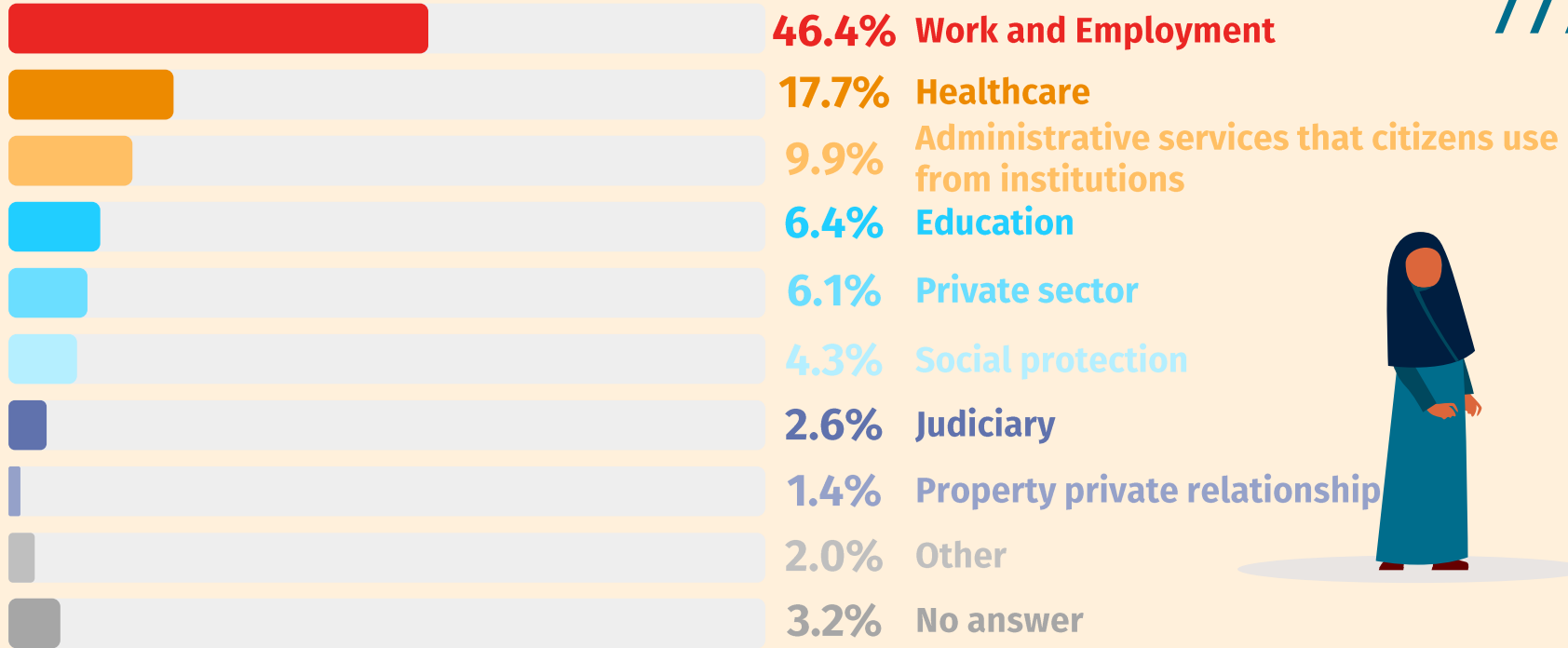
# On what basis have you been discriminated against?

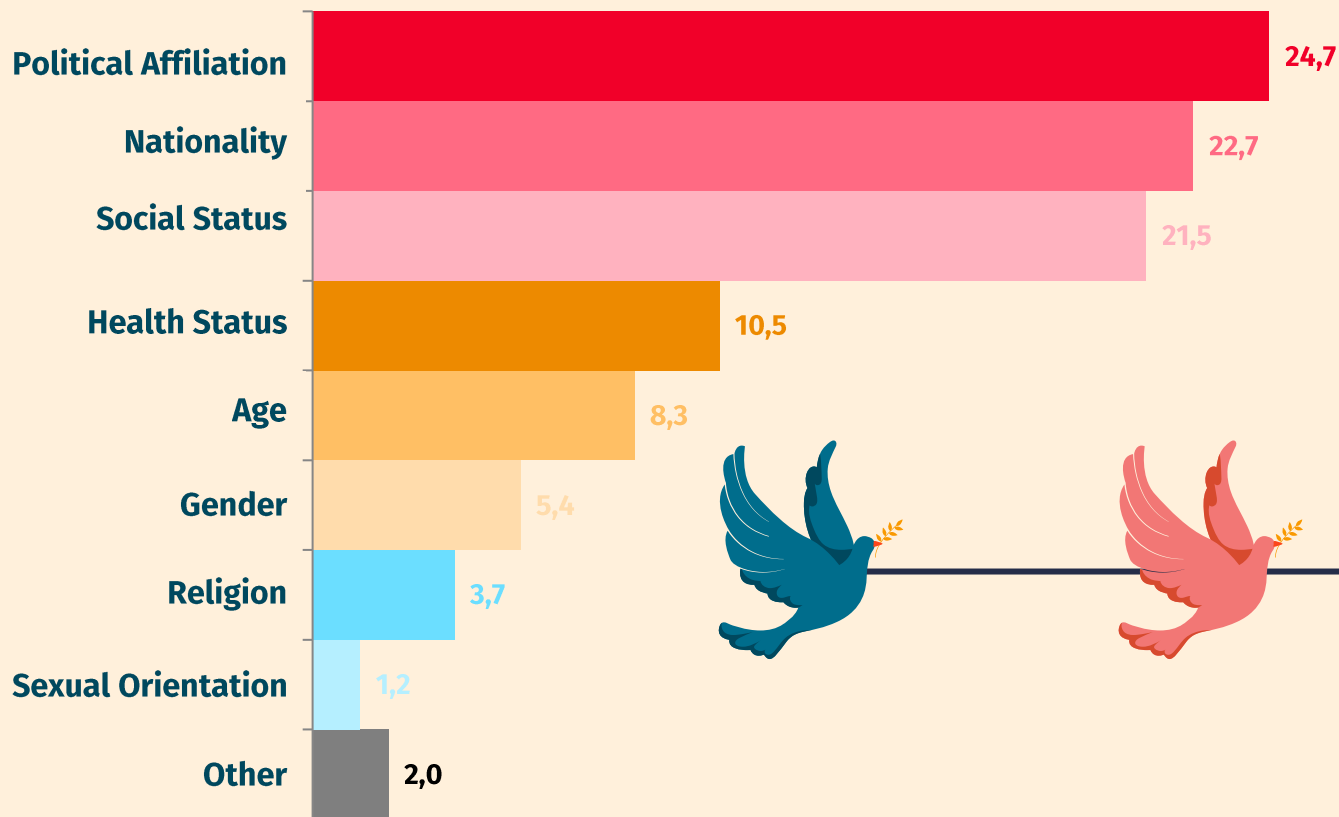

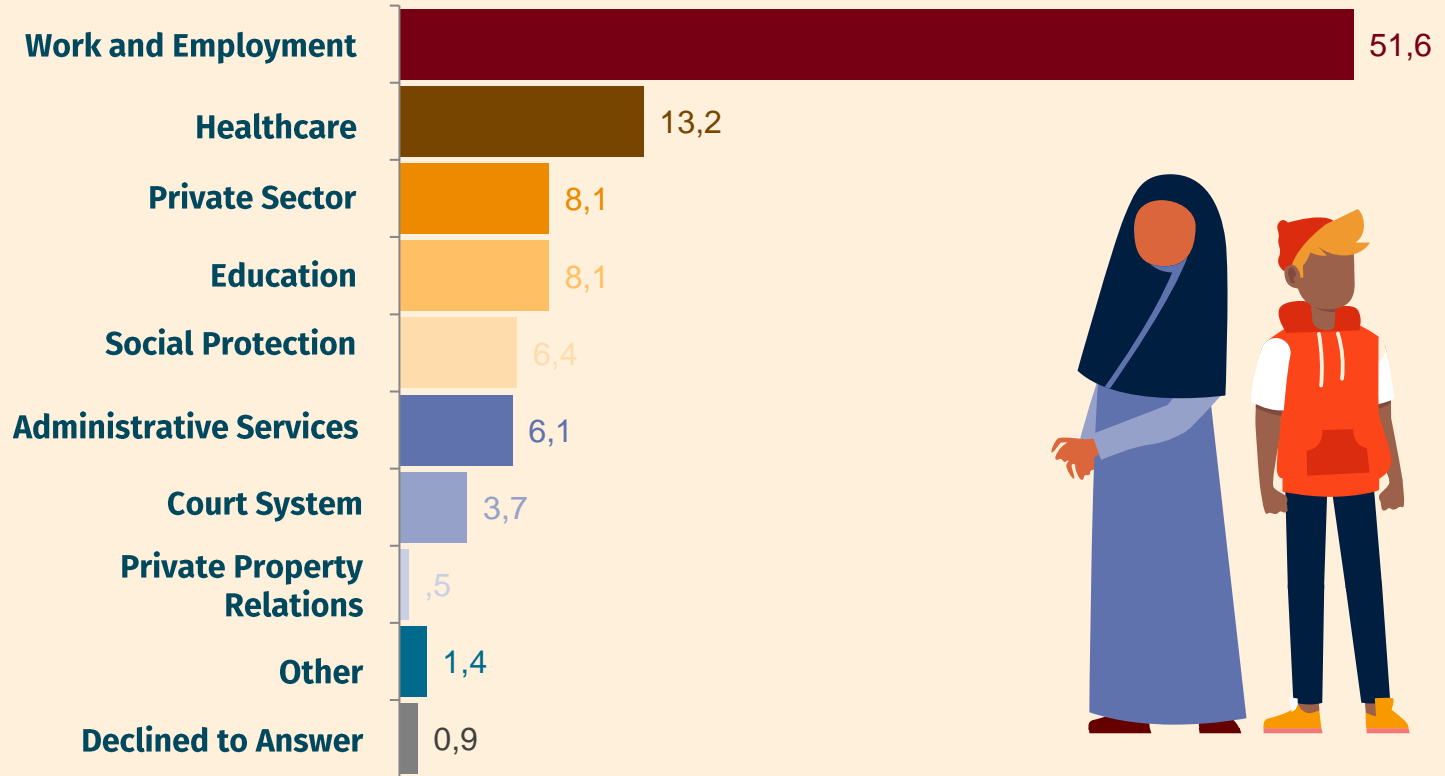

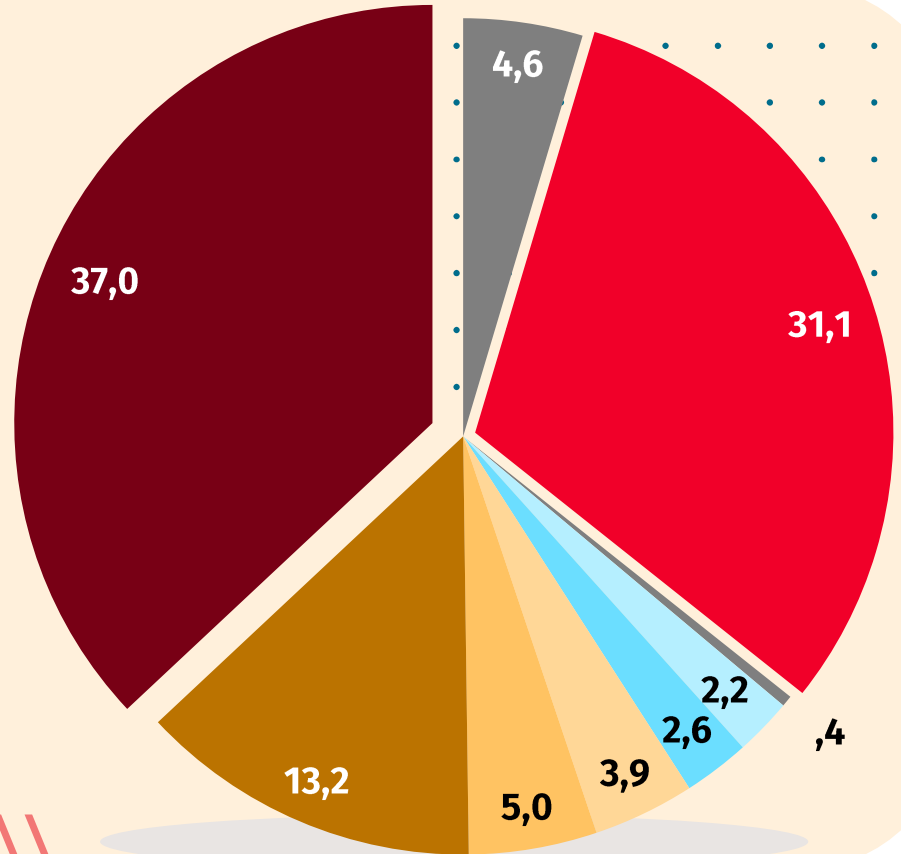

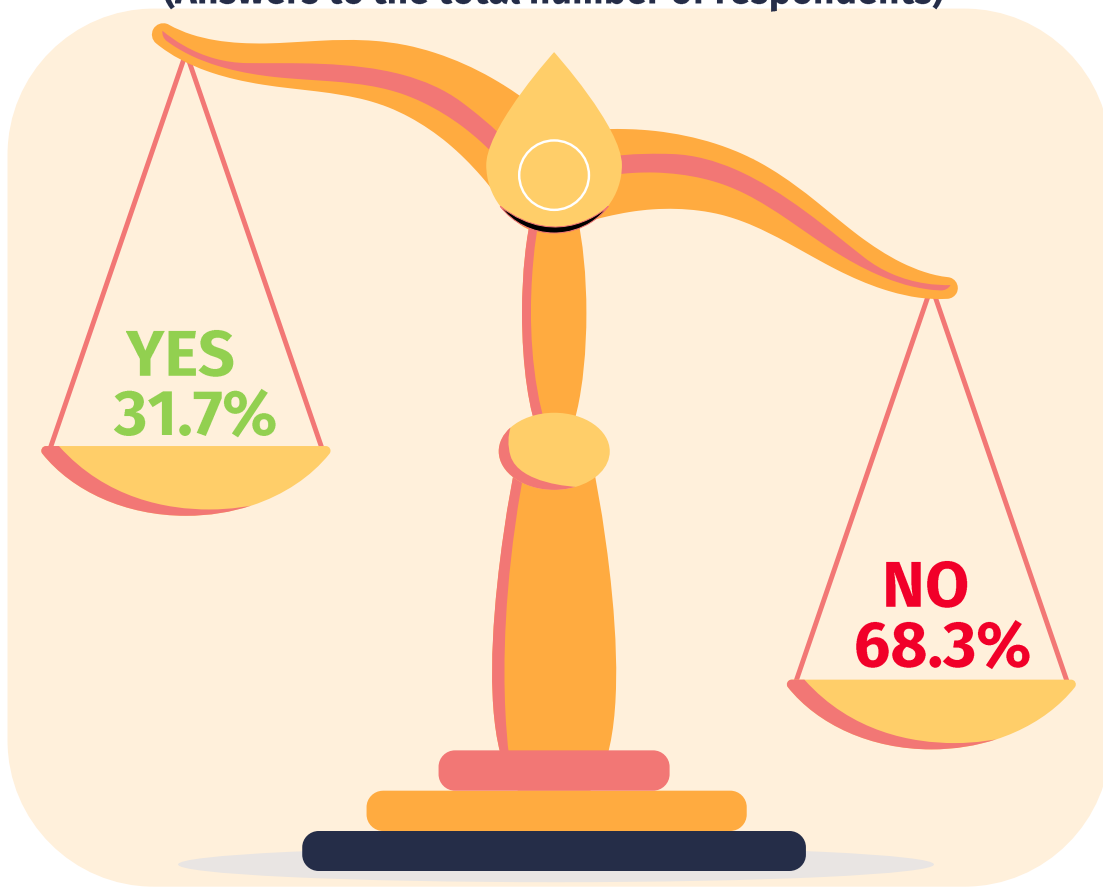

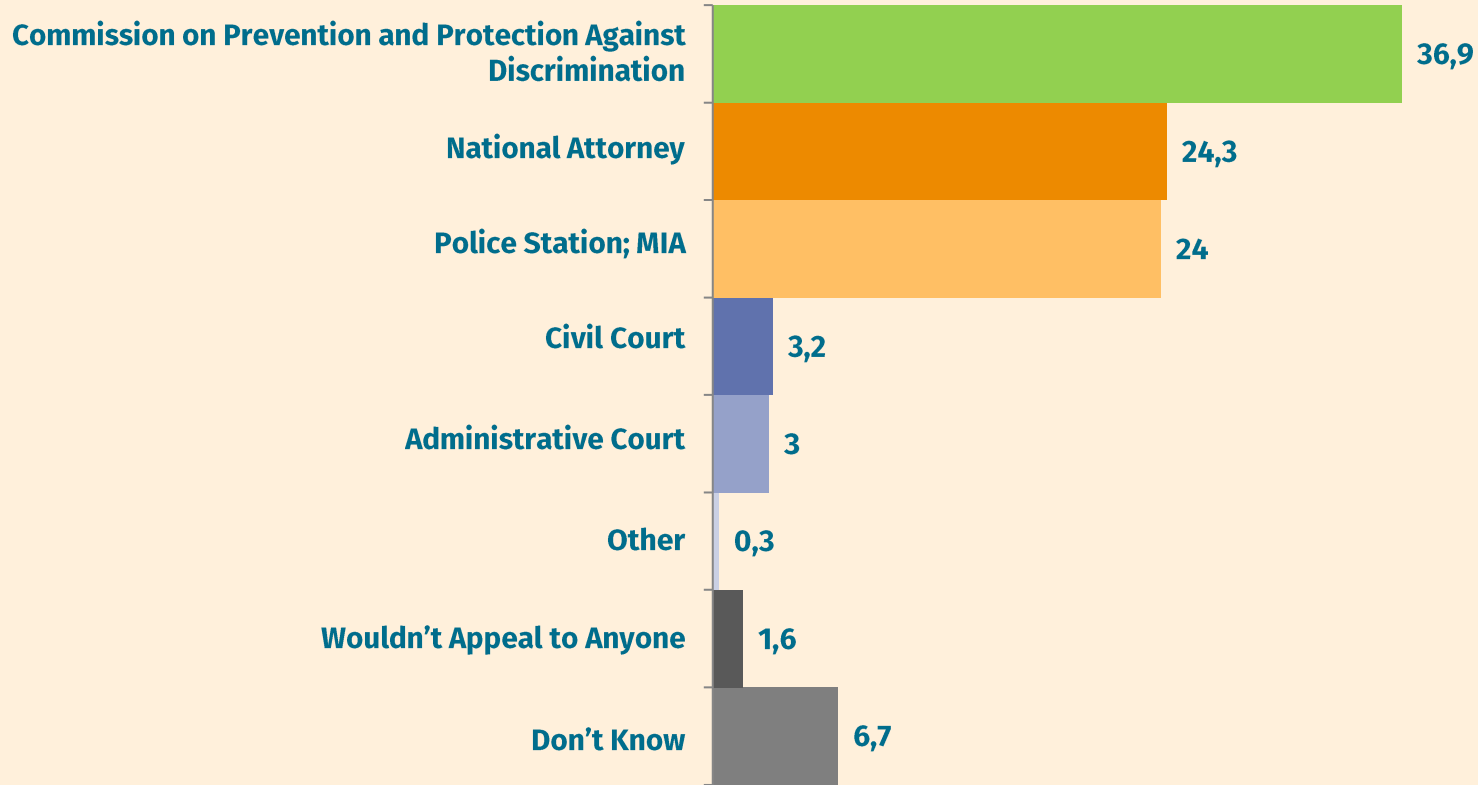

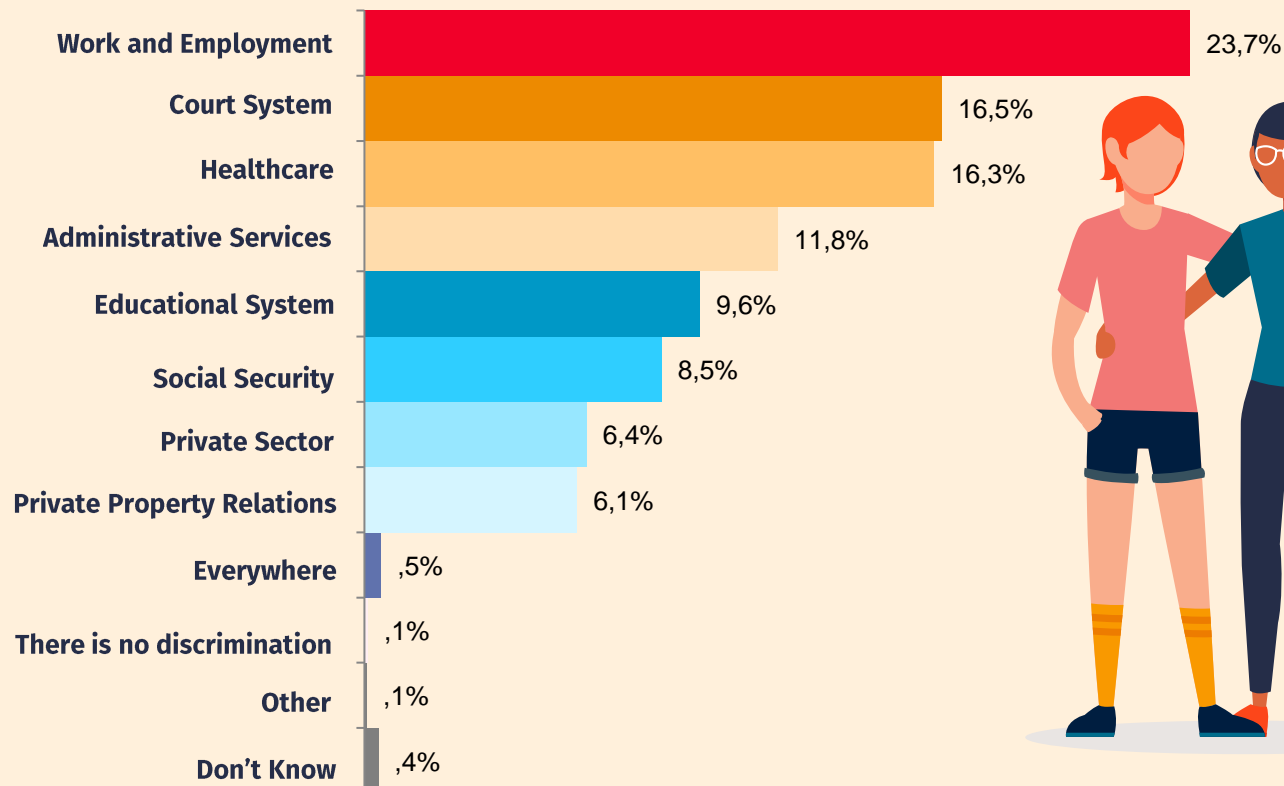
# Which institution would you apply to / where could you apply? (Answers to the total number of respondents)



# Why wouldn't you report to a state institution that you were discriminated against? (Answers to the total number of respondents)

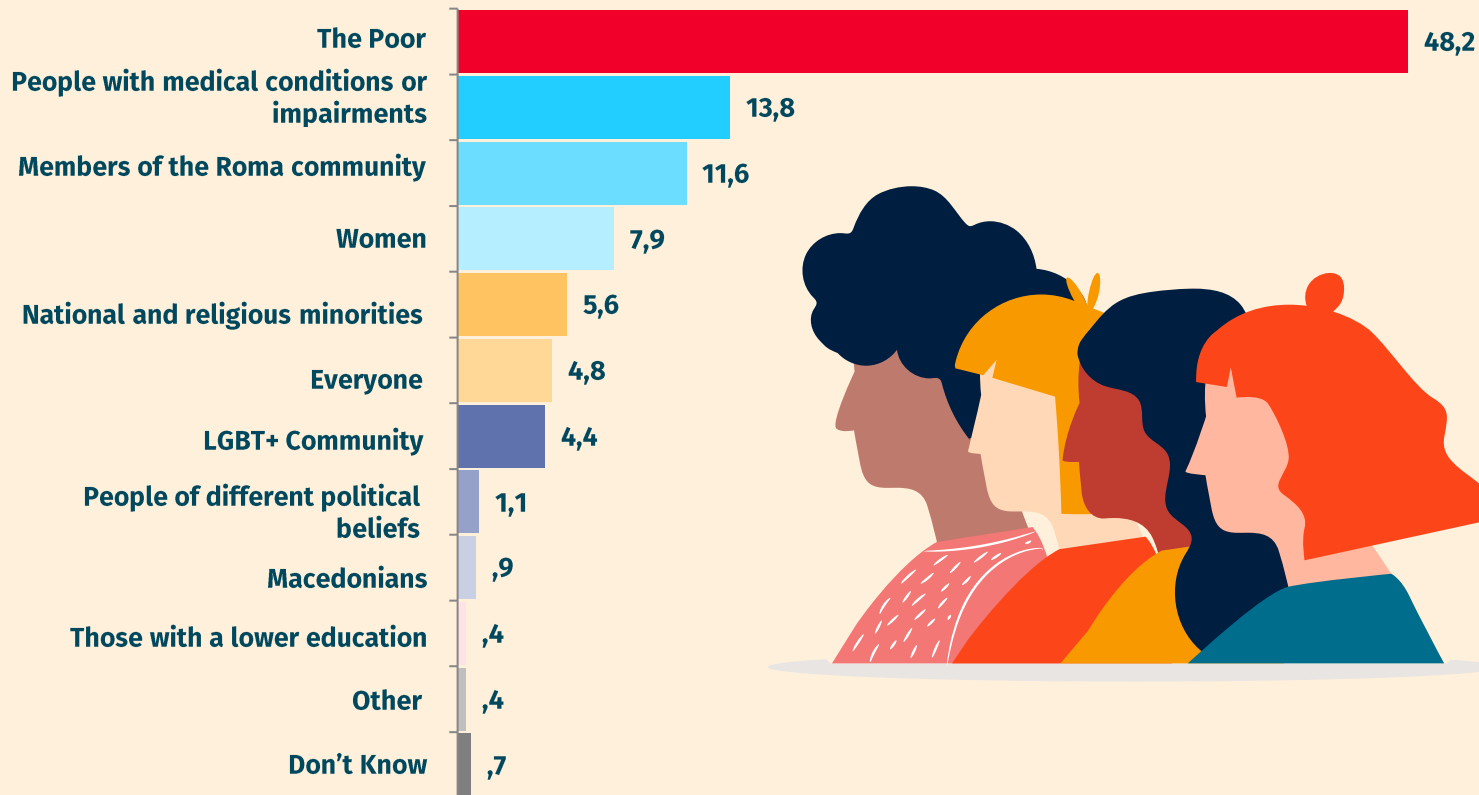


# In which of these areas do you think there is the greatest discrimination in the Republic of North Macedonia? (Answers to the total number of respondents)

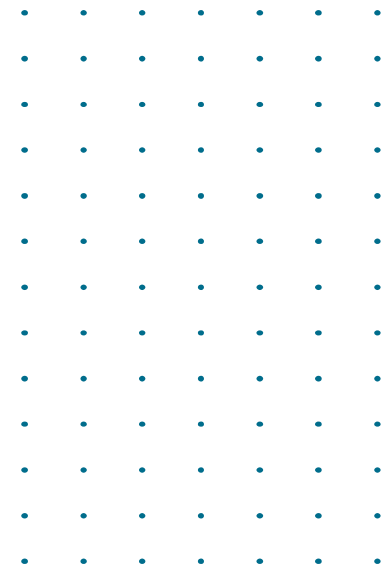
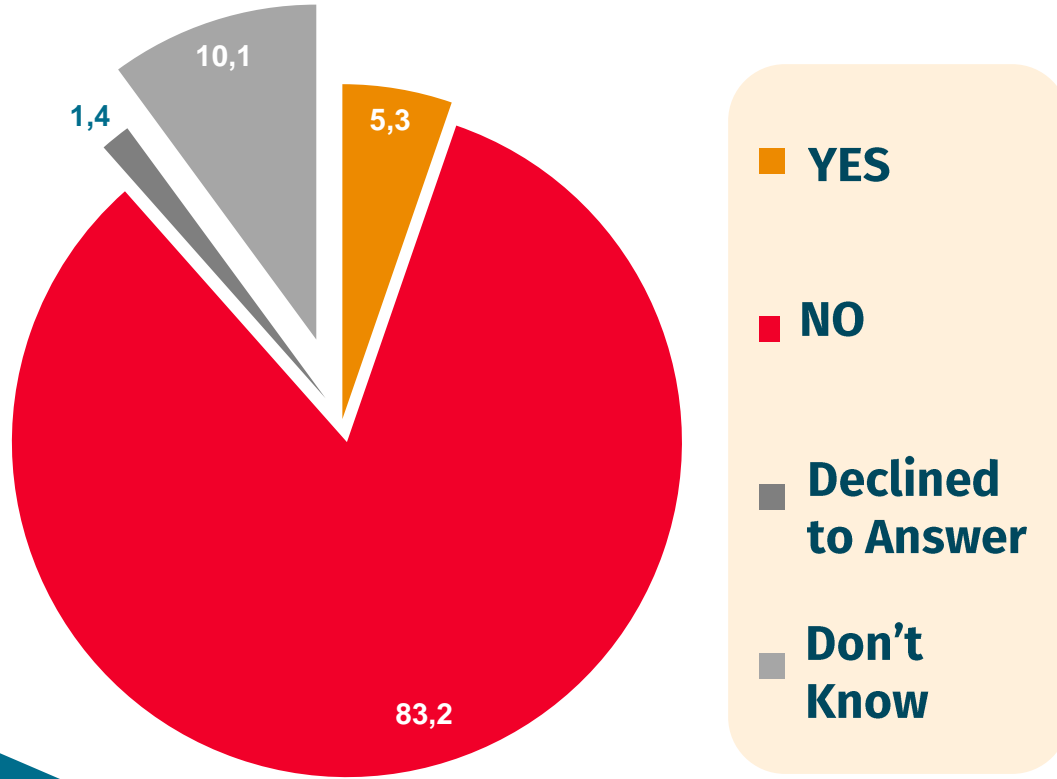




# In your opinion, which group of citizens is most often subject to discrimination in North Macedonia? (Answers to the total number of respondents)
